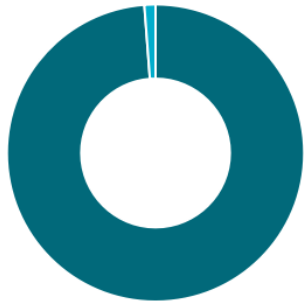

- Conduct microscopic and chemical analyses of laboratory samples and specimens
- Assess patients' diseases or disorders to determine appropriate surgical procedures.
