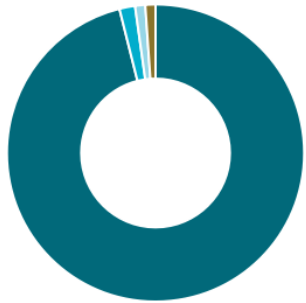

- Perform and assist in routine surgery
- Provide emergency care
- Provide acute care management.
