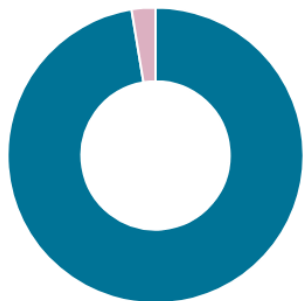

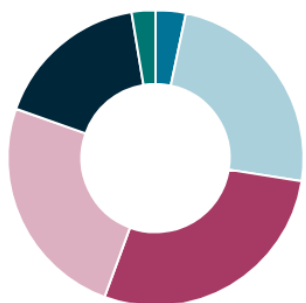

- Examine adjusters' reports and similar insurance claims or precedents to determine extent of insurance coverage.
