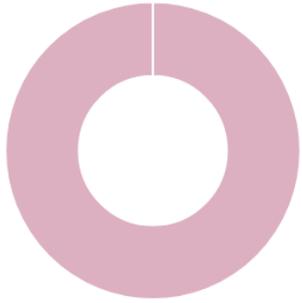

 - Operate media conversion equipment to process and format copy transmitted through telecommunications.
