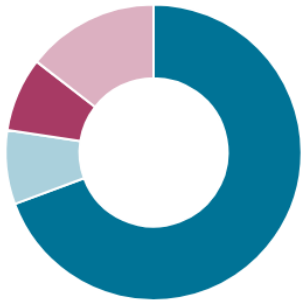

- Requisition materials and supplies

- Recommend personnel actions such as hirings and promotions.
