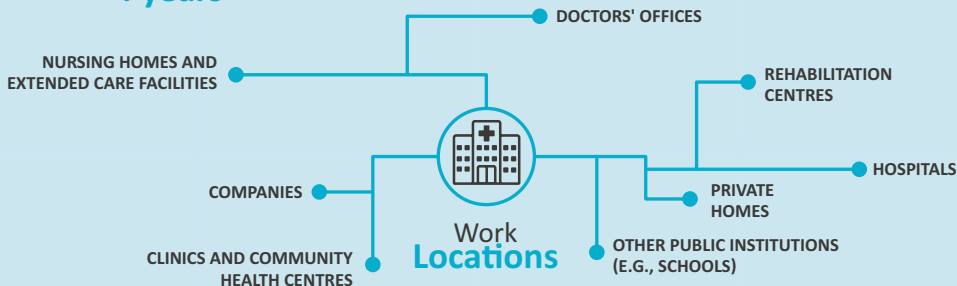

As Home Support Workers, they provide personal care and companionship for clients that need assistance (e.g., seniors, persons with disabilities, etc.) and may perform housekeeping and other home management duties.

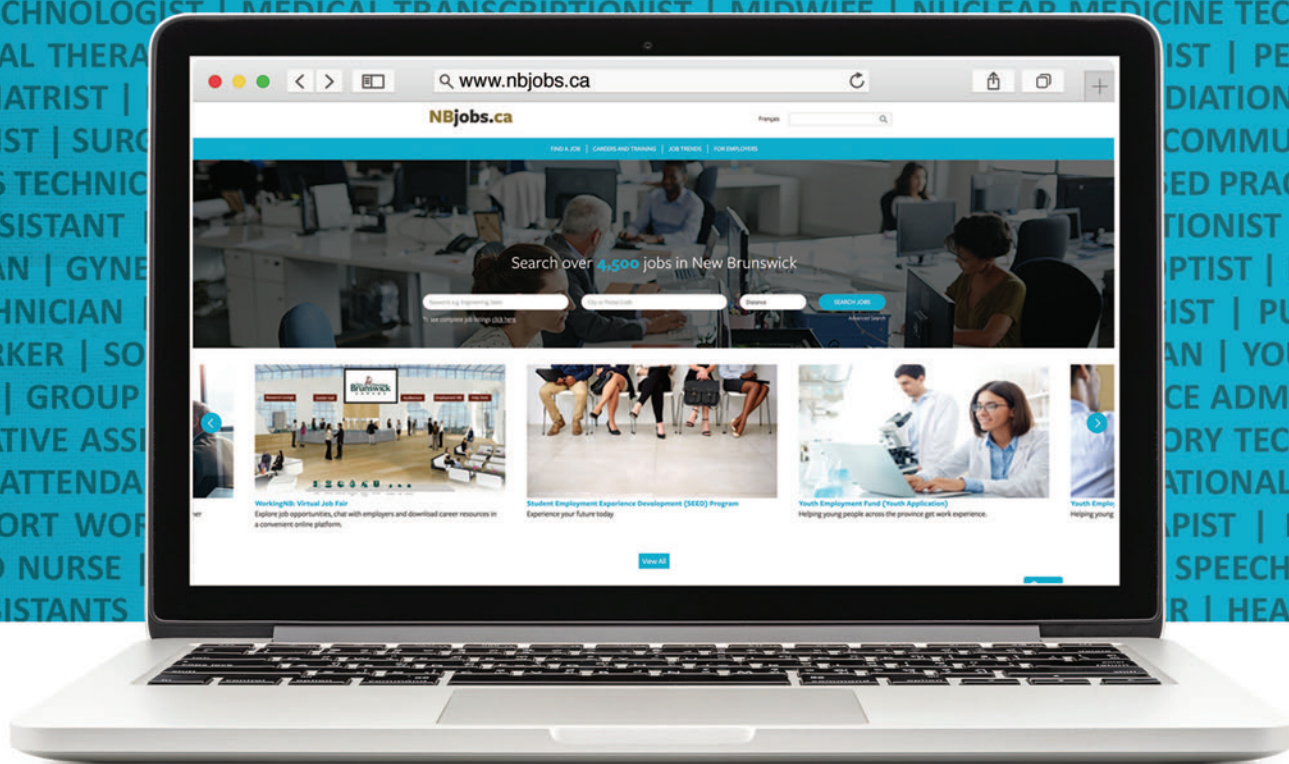
