Registered Nurses (RN) provide professional nursing services, deliver health education programs and provide consultative nursing services to promote, maintain and restore patient health.





Personal Support Workers

Personal Support Workers can serve many roles. As Health Care Aides, they assist health professionals and hospital staff in the basic care of patients usually in an institutional setting. As Home Support Workers, they provide personal care and companionship for clients that need assistance (e.g., seniors, persons with disabilities, etc.) and may perform housekeeping and other home management duties.

Paramedics provide basic and pre-hospital emergency medical care as well as transportation for the sick and injured to hospitals or other medical facilities for further medical care.






