Up from 33% in 2012

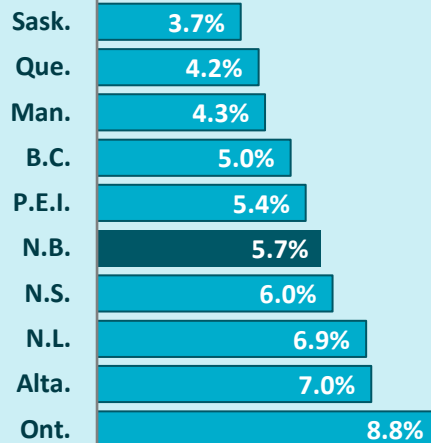


had a post-secondary education
