### **Registered Nurses**

Mainly provide professional nursing care for patients in addition to delivering health education programs. They can work in health care institutions, various organizations, and can be self-employed.









#### **Licenced Practical Nurses**

Provide care for patients under the direction of doctors and registered nurses. They work in health care settings, such as hospitals, clinics and private homes.

### **Elementary Teachers**
