



Install and repair electrical systems designed to provide heat, light, power, control or alarms for all types of buildings and structures.










Plumbers

Install, repair and maintain pipes, fixtures and other plumbing equipment used for water distribution and waste water disposal in residential, commercial and industrial buildings.










Carpenters

Construct, install and repair structures and components of structures made of wood, wood substitutes, lightweight steel and other materials.








Bricklayers

Lay bricks, concrete blocks, stone and similar materials to construct or repair walls, chimneys, fireplaces and other structures.








Roofers and Shinglers

Install, repair or replace flat roofs as well as shingles, shakes or other roofing tiles on sloped roofs.








Welders


Use a variety of welding processes to join metal. They work in many industries, including construction, manufacturing and industrial repair.
