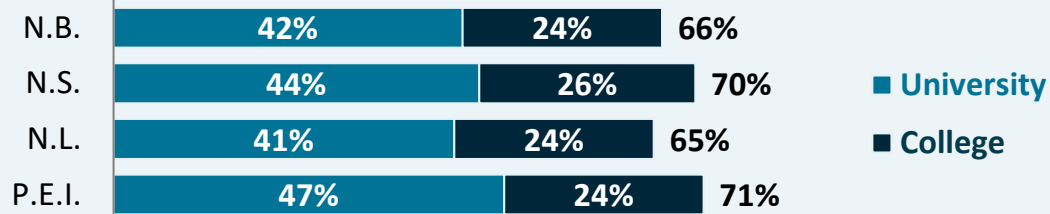


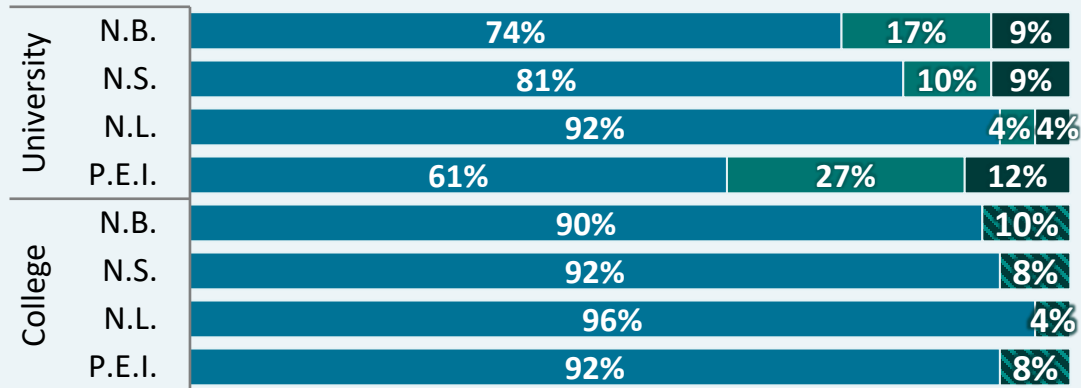
Transition Rate from High School to Post-Secondary

Note 2: For colleges, the "Another Atlantic Province" and "Outside Atlantic Provinces" regions needed to be combined due to small sample sizes

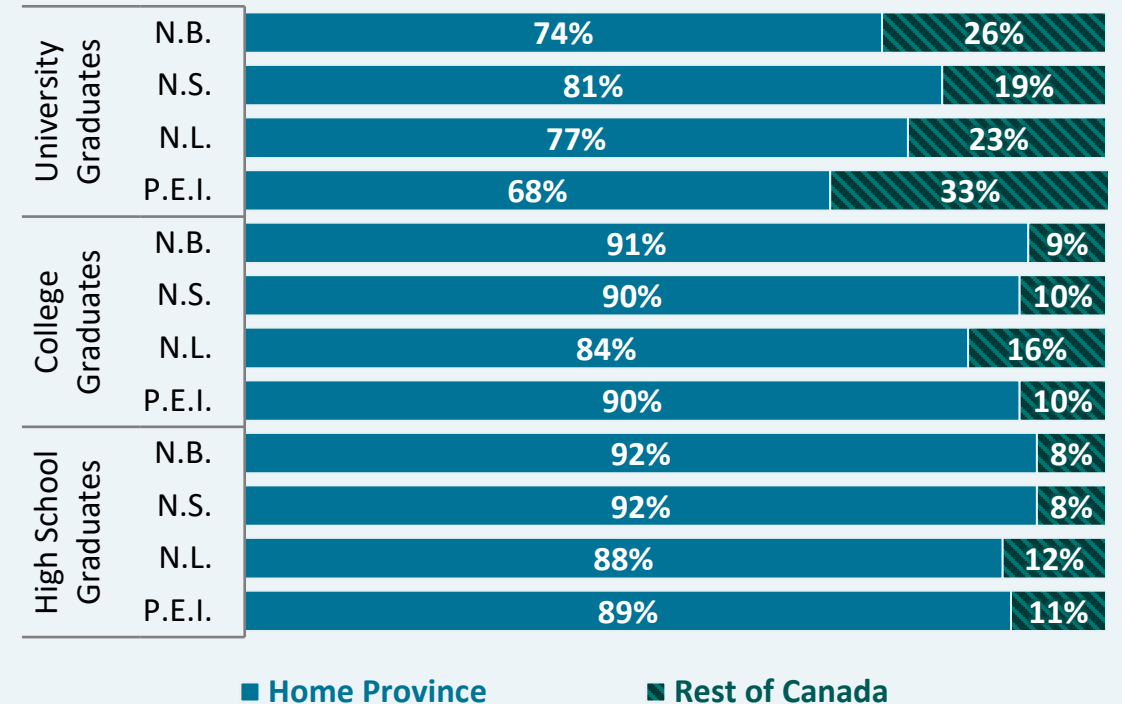
