
HAIRSTYLISTS AND BARBERS (NOC: 6341)

Hairstylists and barbers cut and style hair and perform related services. They are employed in hairstyling or hairdressing salons, barber shops, vocational schools, health care establishments and theatre, film and television establishments.



Completion of a two- or three-year hairstyling **apprenticeship** program or completion of a **college** or other program in hairstyling combined with on-thejob training is usually required.





- Clean and style wigs and hair pieces
- Apply hair extensions
