


















Operate automated lumbermill equipment to saw timber logs into rough lumber, and to saw, trim and plane rough lumber into finished lumber.










Other Wood Processing Machine Operators

Operate wood processing equipment to remove bark from logs, produce wood chips, preserve and treat wood, and produce particleboards, plywood, veneers and similar wood products.










Labourers in Wood, Pulp and Paper Processing

Carry out a variety of general labour and routine wood processing activities and assist pulp mill and papermaking machine operators.








Logging Machinery Operators

Use various heavy machinery and equipment to harvest and process trees at logging sites.











Logging and Forestry Labourers








Silviculture and Forestry Workers


