## Post-Secondary Options



### UNIVERSITY

**Typically Requires 4-6 Years of Study**

Pursue a wide range of degree programs across various fields such as in Arts, Science, Education, and Business

**Typically Requires 1-4 Years of Study**

Work while you study to become a certified journeyman in skilled trades such as Plumbing, Electrical, and Industrial Mechanics (Millwright)

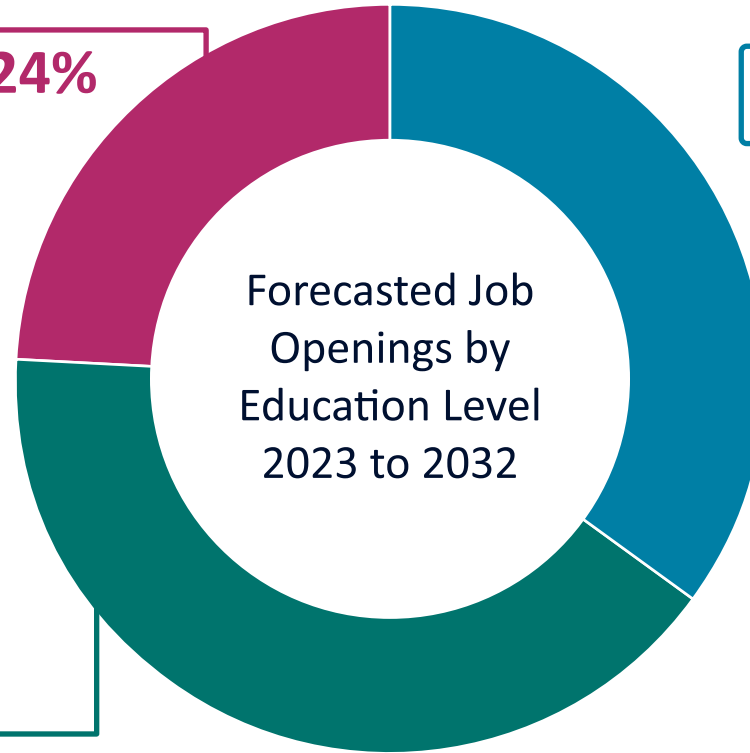

**Typically Requires 1-2 Years of Study**

**Typically Requires 0-1 Year of Study**  
Upskill with programs in the Canadian Adult Education Credential (CAEC), language proficiency, literacy, and Workplace Essential Skills (WES)
