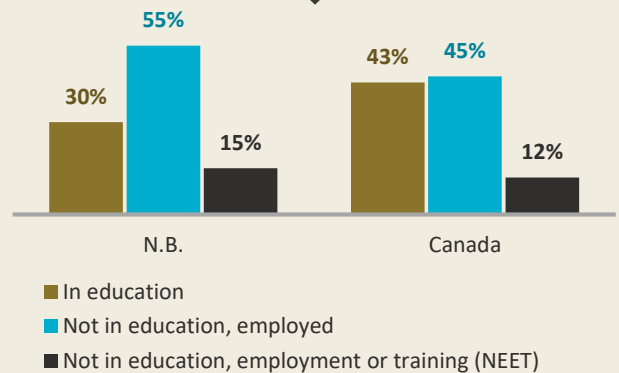

### DESPITE A RELATIVELY HIGH PERCENTAGE OF YOUTH COMPLETING HIGH SCHOOL...



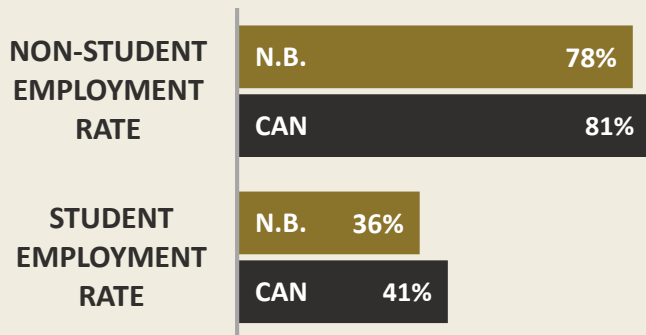
Individuals aged 20 to 29 years; 2016

### MANY NEW BRUNSWICK YOUTH CHOOSE NOT TO PURSUE A POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION



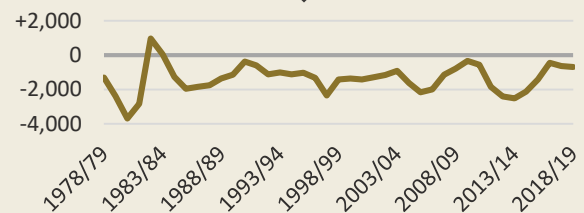
Activity during school months, individuals aged 20 to 24 years; 2018/19

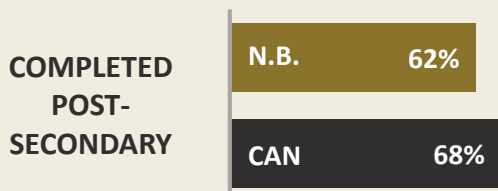
Employment rate during school months, individuals aged 15 to 29 years, 2018/19
